<p><b>Baseline Data Reporting – Behavior Threat Assessment</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Due November 13, 2020 to TEA</b></li> </ul> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Whether your district or charter school has received training on behavioral threat assessment, and established a functioning behavioral threat assessment process.</li> <li>2. The roles of personnel conducting the behavioral threat assessment.</li> <li>3. The number of campuses served by a functioning behavioral threat assessment process.</li> <li>4. The number of threats assessed using behavioral threat assessment during the 2019-2020 school year.</li> </ol> <p>Please note that this data will be collected using a survey and will be based on the activities that occurred from September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020.</p>
<p><b>House Bill 496 Bleeding Control Measures</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bleeding control training is required for charter school personnel who “may reasonably be expected to use a bleeding control station.”</li> <li>• To receive the required certification, the training must be in-person (online training is not allowed).</li> <li>• The law requires district or charter school to offer instruction to students on bleeding control. It does not require students to receive instruction.</li> <li>• Campuses must have “more than one [bleeding control station] per campus”.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Required Trainings</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asked all Principals to complete the online version of the Behavior Threat Assessment Training from the TSSC.</li> <li>• Training needs to be completed by October 29, 2020</li> </ul>
<p><b>Health and Safety (Facility) Committee</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Set future date of meetings</li> <li>• Requires three meetings for year-round districts/charters</li> </ul>
<p><b>MEOP</b></p>	<p>Plans for revisions/updates to current MEOP</p>
<p><b>Campus Safety Drills</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum <b>8 drills</b> per school year</li> <li>• Lockout – 1 per school year; Lockdown – 2 per school year; Evacuate – 1 per school year; Shelter in Place- 1 per school year; Hold – 1 per school year; Fire Evacuation – 1 per school year</li> <li>• Plan for monitoring Principals on safety drills</li> </ul>
