Annual Public Notification of Nondiscrimination

The University of Texas-University Charter School (UT-UCS) offers career and technical education programs in agriculture and business. Admission to these programs is based on being an enrolled student at UT-UCS and opting to enter into CTE program coursework.

It is the policy of UT-UCS not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex or handicap in its vocational programs, services or activities and provides equal access to the Boy Scouts and other designated youth groups as required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.
