We currently have 4 active cases (3 students and 1 staff). 463 rapid test performed since August 2nd We have 299 students enrolled at UTES as of 10.6.21 and there are 500 students at UT-UCS. AED/CPR training being offered per stature which identifies specific staff members. Active COVID case graph reviewed. Discussion on Vaccination Clinic-Mr. Gray asked if there is a timeline. Discussion about Flu Vaccination for staff. Both Advisory boards wrote a letter to UT President to request mandate for mask. President Haskell shared that due to UTCSS being part of UT, he is unable to mandate mask and will provide us UTCSS with rapid test. As of 10.6.21, rapid test have not been received by district. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Gray shared his concern as another wave could be on the horizon based on articles on COVID being cyclical. <p>COVID-19 Testing Program Updates</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The new testing program was reviewed. The new program runs 9/15/21-5/31/22. ● No PPE comes with this program. We will apply for a federal grant to pay for the PPE supplies. ● Rapid Antigen test is BinaxNOW ● 21-22 will be the first year for PCR testing at no cost. ● PCR training with be taking place over the next few weeks. ● Year-Round schools were considered in ordering to ensure test supply for Summer ● Are we encouraging teachers to PCR test at certain intervals? ● Teachers will have access to 1 PCR per week. ● Consent can be a standing consent. ● For students in facilities, who will need to sign off? Discussed roles of CPS staff and facility staff for children who do not have legal parents involved. ● If showing symptoms but negative rapid, student would still quarantine as they are "consumed positive". We can provide PCR testing to get a definitive test result. ● Challenges: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ District parent consent rate for the rapid tests is between 25%-100% participating ○ Need more test administrators 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● UTUCS will offer stipend to COVID test administrators who are consistently helping administer COVID tests. ● Filing for federal grant to cover PPE. ● Both PCR and Rapid test will be available for staff.
